

STEP ONE: Mobility Score and Record Review




- Independent mobility score (RoMS)
- Review of trimming and treatment records to help determine the most common lesions and complete the Lameness Map

STEP TWO: Skills Review



- Farm visit to assess trimming and treatment skills on the farm
- Opportunity to assess horn quality, lesion type and provide some skills training

STEP THREE: Risk Assessment



- Thorough farm walk assessing and discussing main risk factors for lameness
- The Lameness Map is used to help identify the main Success Factors to focus on

STEP FOUR: Action Plan



- Team meeting to discuss the findings from the previous visits and highlight areas for improvement
- Solutions for improved lameness management are discussed and action points agreed

STEP FIVE: Recording, Monitoring and Reviewing



- Independent mobility scores every 3 months
- On-farm review every six months to review and update action plan
