Synopsis

Practical Hoof Trimming and Treatment

Aimed at the vet who already has some trimming and lame cow experience, this highly practical course aims to advance skills and knowledge and introduce new techniques. There will be a strong emphasis on the evidence base and how this can be incorporated practically into lameness management programs on farm.

The following will be covered:

- The 5 step hoof trimming method: An evidence based approach
- Appraising hoof trimming: Identifying bad practices and the impact they have
- Treatment of the lame cow: Creating protocols based on the science
- Blocking: Selecting the correct block and tips for success
- Approaching advanced necrotic lesions: Anaesthesia, analgesia, trimming and aftercare
- The team approach: Establishing vet-trimmer-farmer communication networks and working relationships

Synopsis

BCVA Accredited Foot Health Trainer Course (Lantra Training)

Attendance at this course will allow vets to become BCVA Accredited Foot Health Trainers and therefore deliver the Lantra-approved First Aid for Feet and Intermediate Hoof Trimming Courses in partnership with a CHCSB Approved Instructor. To be eligible to attend vets must be up to date AHDB Mobility Mentors.

This one day course will cover all aspects of delivery of the Lantra programme from set up to delivery. It will enable attendees to familiarise themselves with the structure and content of the courses alongside the materials (handouts and powerpoints) that are supplied to assist delivery. Alongside the speakers, the CHCSB Approved Instructors will be present on the course to enable delivery teams to be established and ensure consistency in training and key messages across the delivery partnership.

There will also be a practical element involving cadaver limbs to build confidence in applying training techniques and ensure consistency when assessing competency levels at the end of each of the Lantra-approved courses.

About the Speakers

Tim Carter is a professional hoof trimmer and Chairman of the Cattle Hoof Care Standards Board (CHCSB). Having grown up on a dairy farm and then worked as a herdsman he trained to become a cattle foot trimmer in 2000. Tim holds both the NPTC Level 3 and Dutch Diploma in foot trimming. He was instrumental in establishing the Royal Agricultural University Level 4 course in professional foot trimming and is the principal instructor on the course. Tim also sits on the Dairy Cattle Mobility Steering Group

Nick Bell has worked on cattle foot health for over 20 years, helping develop a national foot health programme for dairy farmers. He is a European specialist in Animal Welfare and Behaviour Management and RCVS recognised specialist. He was a member of the welfare and behaviour group at Bristol University, firstly as a PhD student and then Research Fellow, before moving to the Royal Veterinary College. He is now honorary associate professor at Nottingham University and director of a herd health and welfare consultancy. Nick works internationally dealing with practical herd health and welfare improvement, dairy herd foot health programmes, training and retailer schemes. He sits on the committee running the Register of Mobility Scorers (RoMS), an instructor for RoMS, he is chief auditor for the Cattle Hoofcare Standards Board, and instructor on the UK Level 4 course in professional foot trimming and he delivers training for the AHDB Healthy Feet Programme. He sits on the industry steering group for foot health and he is an advisor to various organisations including ICAR and RSPCA.
